Project Description

Native vegetation in the Mid North of SA was quickly cleared following colonisation to establish agriculture. In order to reestablish ecosystem services critical for Biodiversity, restoration of woodland buffers to create linkages for threatened species has become a priority within the Clare Valley. This project will undertake re-vegetation in the Wakefield River, along watercourses surrounding Blyth and along the railway corridor between Kybunga and Holyeton. Participants will gain skills in Propagation and Seed Collection
